REMARKABLE PATH TO GROUP ONE GLORY FOR BOSSON

ight weeks ago, leading New Zealand rider Opie Bosson was ready to walk away from racing and retire to the farming life on his Pukekawa property.

Burdened by being unable to ply his trade in the saddle due to the COVID lockdown situation in the Auckland region and with his weight ballooning, Bosson was having serious thoughts about signing off on his riding career.

A timely heart to heart with Te Akau Racing boss, David Ellis reinvigorated Bosson to the point where he committed to riding class three-year-old Noverre (NZ) (Savabeel) in the Gr.1 Al Basti Equiworld Dubai New Zealand 2000 Guineas (1600m) at Riccarton on Saturday.

It was vintage Bosson as he claimed a remarkable eighth

win in the blue riband event, producing a cool, calm and collected effort on the classy Savabeel colt that guided him to an emphatic three length victory.

Reflecting on all that has happened in the past two months, Bosson is adamant that the build-up to Saturday's contest is the most bizarre he has ever experienced.

"It is just so weird what has happened and what it took to get to Riccarton and to win the race," Bosson said.

"Eight weeks ago, I was going to retire.

"The whole stress of lockdown, the uncertainty of what was going to happen in the future and the fact that my weight was getting out of control just had me in a space where I couldn't

see anyway I could keep going with my riding.

"Being stuck in the Auckland region was really confusing as in the first lockdown we were outside the area, but they changed the boundaries and we were in this time.

"We actually live at least 10kms south of the checkpoints and have to travel north to go through them, but we weren't allowed out to go racing in the Waikato or beyond.

"Thankfully I spoke with David Ellis, his wife Karyn and my wife Emily and they convinced me to give it one more go.

"David made a commitment to me that he would help me get my weight down and our target would be the Group One on Noverre."

With the help of Ellis, Bosson made the application to change his residence to Te Akau Stud, which was approved but shortly after making the move there, further drama struck.

"We did everything by the book and got permission to shift to Te Akau and once I was there Dave set about getting my weight down," Bosson said.

"We worked out together, ate the same meals and I had my weight checked every day.

"I knew it was going to be a tough task, but it all fell into place and I was making great progress when COVID threw another spanner in the works, when Hamilton was locked down as well.

"Thankfully we could go through channels again and I manged to be able to shift to Waikato Stud in Matamata and that's where I am currently based."

After all of the rigmarole and impediments to his progress, Bosson was determined to reward those who had supported him with victory in the

Guineas.

"I never get that emotional when I'm riding or have won a race, but I was very emotional when we were pulling up after this one," he said.

"We were actually in all sorts of trouble coming to the turn, but he did what only good horses can do and ended up being a cut and dried winner.

"I haven't ridden a colt like him in a long time, so it is full credit to Jamie and the whole Te Akau team for how they got him to the race in such magnificent order.

"I am also indebted to David for the help he has given me, while I hope the win will also be a real lift for Emily, as she is stuck back on the farm with our son Max and I can't express just how amazing she is with what she has done."

With Bosson feeling like his old self he is keen to continue riding the wave of success during New Zealand Cup Week, where he will ride \$5 third favourite Markus Aurelius (NZ) (Ghibellines) in the Gr.2 Coupland's Bakeries Mile (1600m) at Riccarton on Wednesday before trying to add a second consecutive Gr.1 Barneswood Farm New Zealand 1000 Guineas (1600m) victory for trainer Jamie Richards aboard The Perfect Pink (NZ) (Savabeel) (\$7) after taking out the race in 2020 on Kahma Lass (NZ) (Darci Brahma).

ART DE TRIOMPHE OUT OF 1000 GUINEAS

ndrew Carston was feeling sick to his stomach on Wednesday morning when he discovered his leading Gr.1 Barneswood Farm New Zealand 1000 Guineas (1600m) candidate **Art De Triomphe (NZ)** (Vadamos) lame after a quiet trial at Ashburton the previous day.

Carston had been supremely confident the three-year-old Vadamos filly was ready to run the race of her life next Saturday but is now faced with the prospect of her spending considerable time in rehab after an operation to remove a chip on her knee this week.

"I am just gutted," Carston said.

"I guess you have to chalk it up to the vagaries of racing, but she was going to be my first Group One runner and looked to be in with a real chance based on her lead-up form.

"She had been ticking over nicely after she ran second at Ashburton last month and we gave her the trial to put the finishing touches on her prep.

"She pulled up fine, but when she walked out on Wednesday morning, she was lame and it was all over.

"The vet has diagnosed it as a bone chip, so she is set for surgery on Tuesday and then she will be off the scene for a few months while she recovers."

Carston was philosophical about what has occurred and thankful the filly should be fine to resume her career later in the autumn.

"We've got to the problem very quickly and the prognosis is good for

her," he said.

"It won't be the first disaster we have and probably not the last and I'm looking forward to getting her back as she is a filly with a heap of talent."

Carston will now turn his attention to the second day of the three-day New Zealand Cup Week carnival where he has three runners set to contest the Gr.3 Valachi Downs Canterbury Breeders' Stakes (1400m), while Hasabro (NZ) (Savabeel) will start amongst the favourites for the Gr.2 Coupland's Bakeries Mile (1600m).

"We have a pretty good team in on Wednesday with Severine, Pullyoursocksup and Tamahine in the Breeders' Stakes, while Hasabro looks a top chance in the Coupland's Mile," he said. "I couldn't be any happier with Hasabro as he is just a tough, genuine horse who gives his best every time he steps out.

"He does have to carry topweight of 59kgs, but he is used to carrying big weights and he has been mixing it with most of the horses he faces on Wednesday, so I expect a big run.

"Severine is probably the best of my three in the other race, but it is a very even field where luck will play a big part in the final result."

Hasabro, who finished runner-up in last season's Gr.2 Easter Handicap (1600m), has won two of his three starts from his new southern base after transferring from the Ardmore stable of recently retired trainer Stephen McKee.

SINGAPORE DERBY A TARGET FOR IMPRESSIVE TE RAPA WINNER

rainer Catherine Cameron knows that she has limited time left with impressive Te Rapa winner **Solid Impact** (NZ) (Real Impact) but is keen to make the most of it with the progressive four-year-old.

The son of Real Impact made it three wins in a row when he downed a handy field of rating 74 gallopers over 1600m on Saturday, with the nature of the victory suggesting he will excel over more ground.

Successful in a maiden 1400m at Te Aroha in early October, Solid Impact then dominated a special conditions maiden field over the same distance at Hastings a fortnight later, before completing his hattrick at Te Rapa.

Cameron, who describes her charge as such a laid-back bloke you could picture him lounging around the stable with a beer in his hand, had been concerned the track on Saturday could have been too wet for him but needn't have had any fears as he won convincingly in the hands of apprentice Taiki Yanagida.

"He has always been a nice horse, but we were pleasantly surprised when he won his maiden over 1400m as I didn't think he would be winning until he stepped over more ground," Cameron said.

"He then went to Hastings and did the same and he seems to just keep improving as it was a nice field on Saturday and he did it quite easily in the end.

"He has a very unique action with his head held so low, but he has a massive stride and he just eats up the ground.

"He came home after the race and ate everything we put in front of him and when I went out to see him this morning he



was running around, bucking and carrying on.

"That is quite unlike him as normally he just goes with the flow and lobs around without a care in the world.

"His box is between two of our mares in Cerys and Lily d'Or and you would hardly know he was there at times as you just don't hear a peep out of him."

Purchased for \$250,000 out of the Bradbury Park Book 1 draft at Karaka in 2019, Solid Impact is managed by Hong Kong-based Bloodstock agent Willie Leung for his Hong Kong owner, Johnny Shih.

Leung and Cameron have discussed the options available for the horse in the immediate future, with Cameron advising he is likely to head to Singapore in January to be prepared for the \$\$400,000 Singapore Derby (1800m) later in the year.

"We've had discussions over a long period as where we would go with the horse and at this stage it looks like the Singapore Derby is the main aim," Cameron said.

"The phone has rung hot with offers since his Hastings win, but his owner doesn't want to sell at present.

"I had expected to lose him before now, but I've been told to keep going for the time being so I think I will have him for a couple more starts.

"There is a nice race for him on Counties Cup Day which we will head to and then there may be something at Ellerslie over Christmas."

Cameron also reported that Cheval Prometteur (Declaration Of War), who took out the Gr.3 Balmerino Stakes (2000m) at Te Rapa on Tuesday would now have a short break in the paddock before being prepared for a tilt at the Gr.1 Cambridge Stud Zabeel Classic (2000m) at Ellerslie on Boxing Day.

JUST BECAUSE ANOTHER SMART DEBUT WINNER

uric Stable's latest home-bred **Just Because (NZ)** (Swiss Ace) made a

flying start to his Singapore racing

career with a convincing first-up victory on

Saturday.

After two barrier trials where the Shane Baertschiger-trained newcomer's getaways were tardy, he showed a much edgier side in the \$75,000 Restricted Maiden race over the Polytrack 1200m.

Jumping smartly from his handy barrier, the three-year-old son of Swiss Ace was placed by Danny Beasley in a striking position off the girth of stablemate Dabble (NZ) (Pure Champion), who was overracing upfront.

The race was unfolding towards a winning debut for Just Because and he had

1 ¼ lengths to spare from Super Incredible (Deep Field) with Baertschiger's third runner Big Green Hat (Odyssey Moon) showed his winning turn wasn't far off with a solid third another half-length away.

Baertschiger was obviously pleased he had prepared another debut winner racing in the iconic red and yellow band and armbands, of Auric Stable boss Jerry Sung.

"Jerry's still active in breeding with his two broodmares Just Nini and Jelly Bean. I trained Jelly Bean to four wins here while Bruce Marsh had Just Nini," said Baertschiger.

"This one (Just Because) is a half-brother to Maceo (two wins) as they're both out of Just Nini. He's much bigger and stronger than Maceo.

"Jerry has his mares in Kilmore Farm in New Zealand, and whenever he needs to find a stallion to serve his mares, I'll discuss with him and advise him.

"For example, I suggested he sent Just Nini to Swiss Ace as they go well here at Kranji.

"We knew Just Because had ability, but his barrier manners needed to be worked on. He missed the start at his first trial by five lengths and failed the test.

"At his second trial on Tuesday, he was better even if he was still a length slow, but today, he began well.

"I just told Danny to ride him where he wanted. Dabble went too hard, I'll take the blinkers off at his next start, but the strong pace worked out well for the winner."
